(COLORADO SPRINGS) – Entrepreneur and author, Jane Northrup Glenn, announces her candidacy for Colorado Springs City Council At-Large for 2023.

“I believe Colorado Springs has a divine assignment right now to become a beacon for people seeking freedom. Our nation's firewall broke in 2020 with Covid and now we are headed into some difficult terrain economically, politically, socially, and spiritually from here on out. The reason I'm running for city council is to contend with the global agenda at the local level by cutting financial ties between us and the government at every level. I believe that is our marching order.”

Northrup Glenn founded Authority Staffing, a Christian business prototype that specialized in felon employees and which was recognized by the State of Colorado in 2016 and named "1 of 21 Gospel Driven Businesses" by *Ministry Today*. She was also selected as 1 of 4 business leaders featured in a separate article on the topic of prayer with employees. "Prayer Power" can be found in the 2017 *Building Kingdom Leaders* edition.

Northrup Glenn's current business prototype is the American Christian Marketplace Authority, a membership-based staffing solution that provides housing and other benefits for its workers. The ACMA is a member of the Colorado Springs Chamber but not ready to launch.

In addition to her business endeavors Northrup Glenn was the Director of Resource Development for United Way of Larimer County; an Enterprise Account Manager for data center services; a contractor for a nationally ranked real estate company to develop value-added programs; and the V.P. of Government Affairs for the Pikes Peak Association of Realtors (2019).

Northrup Glenn's campaign website details the following platform:

HOME RULE AUTHORITY AND OVERARCHING FISCAL PHILOSOPHY

- Support minimal use of federal and state subsidies and oppose funds that have environmental or social dictates.
- Support generously funding core services including police, fire, and infrastructure.

- “I believe the government should not participate in public private partnerships or award grants to 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(6) nonprofit organizations.”

OVERARCHING POLITICAL PHILOSOPHY

- Support minimal government intervention into people’s lives and zero government influence over social issues.
- Support free will decisions of the people.
- “As your City Councilwoman, my commitment to you is to examine every issue and determine the best way the government can support both you and your antithesis through impartial ordinances and courses of action.”

LAND USE, PRIVATE PROPERTY RIGHTS AND AFFORDABLE HOUSING

- Oppose future financial incentives and subsidies for builders and developers, including public private partnerships and special tax districts.
- Support freedom to use your property as you please.
- Oppose the government’s intervention in home affordability.
- “Having a heart for the poor, marginalized, and oppressed, I have conceptualized several non-government solutions to help people in this area (housing). These solutions can be implemented immediately, with no legislation, and mutually benefit the property owner and resident.”

LOCAL SUSTAINABILITY

- Support decentralization of activities and organizations.
- Support ways to make it easier for people to work for themselves, grow their own food, use their land and home as a source of income, and establish micro-communities.
- “As your City Councilwoman, I commit to listening to your ideas and researching what needs to be done to give you what you need. I commit to proposing new ordinances or unwinding current ones to make things happen.”
